ORDINANCE 2025-03

AN ORDINANCE AUTHORIZING AN EMERGENCY APPROPRIATION UNDER N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53 FOR THE PURPOSE OF PREPARING AND DIGITIZING TAX MAPS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF NORTH HANOVER

Be it ordained by the Township Committee of the Township of North Hanover, County of Burlington, State of New Jersey as follows:

Section 1. Pursuant to N.J.S.A. 40A:4-53, the sum of \$16,000.00 is hereby appropriated for the purpose of the preparation and digitization of of the tax maps of the Township of North Hanover, and shall be deemed a special emergency appropriation as defined and provided for in N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55.

Section 2. The authorization to finance the appropriation shall be provided for in succeeding annual budgets by the inclusion of at least 1/5 of the amount authorized pursuant to this act (N.J.S.A. 40A:4-55).

Section 3. This ordinance shall take effect upon its passage, approval, publication and filing according to law.
