## Glass Bottles and Jars

Labels are okay! **No caps or lids.** 

## Metal CANS Only Remove labels on

aluminum cans. **Don't crush!** 





**NO** shredded paper

**NO** Styrofoam



**No** plastic bags, wrap, plastic envelopes, or shipping packaging

No plant pots, straws, trays, lids, cups, or loose caps

**NO** hoses or hangers <sub>C</sub>

**NO** hardback books, food soiled, or frozen food boxes

- **NO** foil items, bulbs, cookware, or window glass
- **NO** motor oil, batteries, or hazardous items

# CARDBOARD RECYCLING RULES

 We find hazardous items, like needles and batteries in boxes that residents set out for recycling.
